Helpline House Thanksgiving Food Drive

Frequently, people will ask, "Are there really hungry people on Bainbridge Island?" or "Who uses the Food Bank?". Each month, the Helpline House food bank distributes about 30,000 pounds of food to nearly 350 families who do not have enough money to buy adequate food. Many of the new clients are newly unemployed, but the majority of those who come to the food bank have jobs; jobs that pay wages too low to cover all family expenses in a high cost of living area. Only 5 to 10% who use the food bank are homeless or threatened with homelessness.
