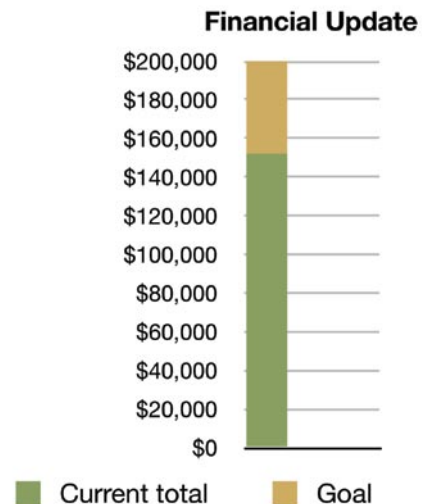
Host Family needed for 2010-11 School Year

4th Quarter Financial Challenge

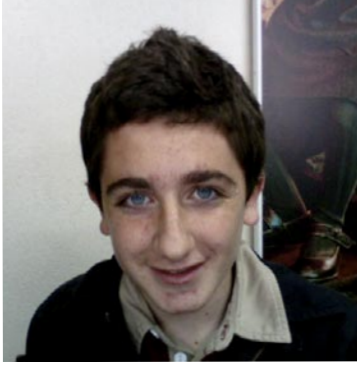
