

WEEK 6 DAY 1 John the Baptist Was Born

Step 1: Watch:

"John Was Born" Gospel Project Video: https://www.crosssound.org/family-videos

Step 2: Discuss

- 1. Can anyone tell me whose family we learned about last week? Yes! We learned about Jesus' family. You can find stories about many of the people in Jesus' family throughout the Old Testament. God promised to send a Messiah from the Jewish people. The New Testament begins with God's keeping that promise.
- 2. Two week ago we learned about the Prophet Malachi. Who did he prophesy would come?
- 3. After 400 years of silence, what were God's first words to his people? Read Luke 1:13 to find the answer.

Step 4: Review

• Story point: John was born to prepare the way for Jesus.

• Big picture question: Is Jesus God or human? As the Son of God, Jesus is both fully God and fully human.

Step 5: Pray

Ask for everyone to share a prayer request and something they want to thank the Lord for, and then take turns praying out loud.

Curriculum Notes:

Between the Book of Malachi (the last book in the Old Testament) and the Gospels (the first books in the New Testament) God was silent. He did not speak directly to His people for 400 years. A lot changed for God's people during that time. The rulers in Rome took over, and some people might have wondered if God forgot about His people. Did God forget? No! In today's Bible story, we heard what God said when He finally broke the silence.

Malachi said that someone would come before Jesus. The person who would get people ready for Jesus was John!

- 2. When Mary went to visit Elizabeth (both carrying children), how did baby John react in Elizabeth's belly?
- 3. How did both Elizabeth and Mary respond?



BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

- An angel told Zechariah that he and Elizabeth would have a son.
- God made Zechariah unable to speak because he did not believe.
- Zechariah was able to speak again when his son, John, was born.
- John was born to get people ready for Jesus.

KEY PASSAGE: John 1:1

BIG PICTURE QUESTION:

- Speak a blessing over your children by name. Pray that God would use them to advance His kingdom and prepare the world for Jesus' return.



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




STORY POINT: JOHN WAS BORN TO GET PEOPLE READY FOR JESUS.

John would go ahead of the Lord and get people ready for His coming. Zechariah asked the angel, "How can I know this will happen?"

The angel said, "God sent me to tell you this good news. Because you did not believe my words, you won't be able to speak until these things happen."

Zechariah left the temple. The people

outside realized he had seen a vision and could not talk. Zechariah went home to Elizabeth. In time, she became pregnant and gave birth to a son.

Zechariah and Elizabeth named their son John. Suddenly, Zechariah could speak again. The Holy Spirit filled John. Zechariah praised God and told the people God's words: "God has come to help His people. He will save us through David's family. He will rescue us from our enemies."



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WEEK 6 DAY 4 John the Baptist Was Born

Step 1: Read

Luke 1:57-66

Step 2: Discuss (see curriculum notes below to help guide these questions)

- 1. What did Zechariah do after his son was born? Prompt kids to recall that Zechariah named the baby John, just as the angel commanded. Then he was able to speak, and he prophesied about John, saying he would go before the Lord and get people ready for Him. (Option: Choose a volunteer to read Luke 1:76-68.)
- 2. The name John means "the Lord is gracious." Where do you see God's grace in the Bible story or in your own life? Encourage kids to give examples. Help them recognize God's grace in giving a son to Zechariah and Elizabeth. Guide them to consider undeserved favor in their lives, especially the gracious gift of salvation through Jesus.
- 3. What did their neighbors observe, and what did it make them wonder?

Curriculum Notes:

Zechariah did not believe the angel Gabriel at first. Zechariah knew that he and his wife were too old to have children. However, one wonderful thing about God is that He has power over all things. Nothing can stop His plans, and He often does things no one else could do to prove His power and love. Despite their old age, Zechariah and Elizabeth had a baby just as God promised. God is faithful, and all His promises come true. John was filled with the power of the Holy Spirit even as a baby! God had plans for John, and John's birth was like a small glimpse at the birth of the Messiah still to come. John was born to prepare the way for Jesus.

Step 4: Review

• Big picture question: Is Jesus God or human? As the Son of God, Jesus is both fully God and fully human.

Step 5: Pray

Ask for everyone to share a prayer request and something they want to thank the Lord for, and then take turns praying out loud.

Curriculum Notes:

Encourage kids to think about their friends and family members who may not love Jesus. Discuss ways to show them God's love and share the gospel with them. Remind kids that even people who know and love Jesus need to be pointed to Jesus to help them remember how good He is. Discuss with the kids how difficult times can make it hard to trust God, but they can also push us toward the Lord as we learn to rely on Him for support. Remind kids that the Bible teaches we should praise God in good times and difficult times.

God's people hadn't heard from God for 400 years, but God didn't forget His plan to save people from their sin. Zechariah believed God's word, and he praised God. John was born to prepare the way for Jesus. John would point people to Jesus, and they would praise God for keeping His promise to send the Savior. Ultimately, Jesus died on the cross and rose again to glorify God and make the way for us to be saved to glorify God as well.
